About Seemanta Chetana Mancha Purvottar:

Seemanta Chetana Mancha Purvottar, is a registered socio-cultural organization founded for creating awareness to protect our national borders by promoting the values of patriotism and nationalism. The organization is committed to nation building process primarily with the people from the International Border Areas of the whole of North Eastern Region. Our platform maintains that the International Border Areas of our country are to be safe and secured for the highest order of peace, amity and development among the citizens. For that the organization has some yearlong scheduled programs like the celebration of Pratistha Divas, Desh Bhakti Samabesh, Bharat Mata Puja, Raksha Bandhan, Shakti Pujan and non-scheduled programs like, workshop, seminars and appointed lectures etc. All the activities of the organization are categorically aimed at (a) help protecting the international borders, (b) make general people aware about the issues of international borders and (c) helping statutory organizations to implement the official welfare programs in such places.

VISION:

- > To promote patriotism among the people of our country in general and those living in the international border areas in particular and to organize & integrate the society at border with the midland for national upliftment and to stand as wakeful sentinel of the international borders of our Motherland Bharat.
- > To plan and work for the economical, social, cultural, educational, intellectual, physical, health and sporting development of the people living in the international border areas and to eradicate any social differences by encouraging development of the villages through traditional unity, amity and brotherhood.
- > To strive for eradication of wrong customs, superstitions and any other social evils present in the society by organizing various meetings, exhibitions, seminars, symposium, trainings, etc. from time to time.
- > To arrange educational facilities, establish hostels for students of unprivileged and weaker section of society and also to set up library

and facilities for news, media, communication, etc. of nation and abroad as per necessity.

- > To bring awareness about all the programs, facilities, grants, schemes, etc. declared by the State and the Central Governments among the people living in the international border areas.
- > To provide training for economic self-reliance and skill development aiming to generate and augment the livelihood of the people living in the international border areas.
- > To plead and demand before the Government for construction of barb wired or any other high-tech wall on the '0' line along the international borders for the safety and security of our border and nation.
- > To involve and integrate army, defense, military, para-military or other security agencies & Government administrations with the society for appropriate border management and national security, because the responsibility of our borders is of all.
- > To help the Government administration at the time of crisis of whatsoever manner in the border areas for the interest and welfare of the mass people and to strive for ensuring border security, national security, unity and all-round development so as to transform our motherland Bharat to a "Vishwa Guru" again.

MISSION:

- > Towards attainment of the organization's 'vision' by promoting patriotism & nationalism among the people of our country in general and the international border areas in particular through organizing various plans, programs, meetings, seminars, symposiums, exhibitions, activities, sports, village-meetings, charities, services, etc. with "Vyakti Nirman to Rashtra Nirman" and work in an integrated way with the security agencies, Government administrations and the society for border security, national security, self reliance, all round development and unity among the people of our great motherland Bharat.

2. Annual Calendar Programs of the Mancha:

I. Raksha Bandhan:
